

PERMISSION TO TRAVEL FORM FOR MINORS

Minors under the age of 18 traveling from the United States to any foreign destination, when not accompanied on the trip by parents, should have a notarized affidavit from the parent not accompanying the child that:

1. The child is traveling out of the United States with the permission of the parent.
2. That the non-traveling parent is aware that the child is leaving on the departure date and
3. The name(s) of the person(s) accompanying the child.

If the minor child is leaving the country without either of his or her parents, both parents must provide a notarized signed affidavit as outlined.

We are asking all minors to have **BOTH PARENTS** sign **two (2) permission forms**, which **MUST** be notarized. If parents are not together, consent from both parents is still necessary. If one parent is the custodial parent, please indicate this on the form.
