

21 DAYS OF PRAYER

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE; WEEK 2



Sunday: In Revelation 2 Jesus speaking to the church at Ephesus says that they have left their first love. It can be easy to get used to what we have and begin to look for something else. Read Paul's prayer for the church in Philippi in Philippians 1:9-11. Let that prayer guide your prayer today.

Monday: This summer we have focused our Sunday morning messages on discipleship. Today take the time to sit down and prayerfully reflect on what God has stirred in you in the last few months. What are life's circumstances causing you to deal with? Pray for God to reveal to you what He might be leading you to focus in on growth.

Tuesday: Following up on what came from your prayer time yesterday, today we want you to prayerfully explore what opportunities there are to open yourself to God's working in your life. There are a number of opportunities here at CHCC. There are many other resources available to you. Prayerfully look for what you can do to open yourself to God's movement in your life.

Wednesday: Pray today for sensitivity to the Holy Spirit. Take the time to stop and intentionally be still and listen. Pray for a growing intimacy with God.

Thursday: In Matthew 13 Jesus tells the parable of the sower. He tells us that some of the seed fell on rocky ground and when the sun came up the plants withered because there wasn't enough soil to support them. As we follow Jesus we need to pray for strength to sustain us in the journey. Strength for the walk and strength of conviction to go where He leads.

Friday: Read James 1:5-7. James talks about praying for wisdom. He says if any of you lack wisdom he should ask God. I don't know about you all but this is a prayer that I recognize I need to make regularly. I need to seek the wisdom of God in my daily life. Pray for wisdom today in regard to your discipleship. What is it that God is leading you to do to open yourself to the continuing work of His Spirit in you?

Saturday: How does God see you? What does He see when He looks at you? There are many texts that tell us of His love. Romans 1:6 reminds us that we are also called to belong to Jesus. Take at least 60 seconds to stand in front of a mirror and pray for God to let you see you the way He sees you.
